The instant application has been filed under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 seeking withdrawal of the present writ petition.

An application has been moved by the petitioner that on account of a delay, the condition of the dead body lying the mortuary was deteriorated and it had become difficult to shift the same from United Kingdom (U.K.) to Punjab. Hence, the cremation has been done in U.K.

In view of the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed.
