VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 to 4 to take action by complying with the provisions of Sections 273, 274 of the Punjab Municipal Corporation Act, 1976 with regard to building/property No.1072/II-24 and 1873/II-24, situated in Gali Sita Ram, Katra Ahaluwalia, Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No.6 has submitted that

respondent No.6 would make the building safe within a period of two months from today.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in case, the building is not made safe within a period of two months from today then liberty be granted to the petitioner to move a representation to the Municipal Corporation after a period of two months and the Municipal Corporation be directed to look into the said issue.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents have no objection to the said course of action.

5. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.6 to make the building in question safe within a period of two months from today.

6. It would be open to the petitioner to move a detailed representation to respondent No.3 in case, the said building is not made safe within a period of two months from today and the Municipal Corporation would then consider the said representation and take appropriate action, in accordance with law.

7. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
