1. In the present petition, challenge is to order dated 04.03.2022 (Annexure P/5) by which, the petitioners have been asked to submit the application along with sports gradation certificate in terms of notification dated 25.05.2018.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners will be making available the said gradation certificate for consideration of the authorities concerned within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and the respondents may kindly be directed to consider the same so as to pass an appropriate order in terms of impugned show cause notice and till then, the petitioners be allowed to continue in

service.

3. Learned State counsel submits that in case any sports gradation certificate is received from the petitioners within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, the same will be given due consideration and an appropriate order in terms of impugned show cause notice will be passed and in case the sports gradation certificate submitted by the petitioner is found to be valid, appropriate relief will be granted to them failing which, due reasons will be given in the speaking order, which will be passed in pursuance to the impugned order dated 04.03.2022.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that in case no sports gradation certificate is submitted by the petitioners within a period of 08 weeks, an appropriate order on the show cause notice will be passed and till then the petitioners will be allowed to continue in service.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

6. Ordered accordingly.
