1. Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioners, at the hands of private respondents No.5 to 7.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner has become owner and in possession of the properties of his father namely Tara Chand, who died on 22.06.2022, situated at Village Gadauli, Tehsil Naraingarh, District Ambala by way of Registered Will dated 28.10.2016 (Annexure P-1). It has further been submitted that private respondents, who are relatives of the petitioners, are threatening the petitioner in order to sell the properties at throwaway prices to them but the petitioner is not willing to sell these properties. In this regard, representations, both dated 15.06.2023, were made by the petitioner to respondents No.3 and 4 but no action has been taken on them till date. Hence, she is seeking protection of

her life and liberty in that regard and has approached this Court by way of filing the instant petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of Court, Mr. Sharan Sethi, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

5. In view of the above, the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.3 –Superintendent of Police, District Ambala to look into the representation dated 15.06.2023 (Annexure P-4) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioner is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents. However, this direction will have no effect on any civil or criminal action, which could be initiated in the matter in accordance with law.
