The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. Seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.1 for taking an appropriate legal action against respondent Nos.2 to 6 for their complete inaction on complaint dated 03.07.2021, which is against the mandate of Section 42 of the NDPS Act.

As per office report, fresh notice to respondent Nos.4 & 5 could not be issued as counsel for the petitioner did not take necessary steps to serve respondent Nos.4 & 5.

On issuance of notice of motion, affidavit of Mr. Vivek Sheel Soni, Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar (respondent No.2) was filed in Court.

In Para-4 of the said status report, it has been submitted that Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Kharar-I, District SAS Nagar submitted a report dated 02.09.2022 with the findings that complaints moved by the petitioner including Annexures P-1 dated 03.07.2021 and P-11 dated 18.07.2022, were duly inquired into, however,

finding no truth in the same and no action was required by the police on the said complaints, the same were filed in the office, respectively.

Since the said assertion has not been controverted by the petitioner by filing any rejoinder/counter to the affidavit filed by the respondent-State of Punjab, therefore, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same stands disposed off accordingly.
