[1] This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0024 dated 14.02.2023, under Sections 379, 411 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

[2] There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners. Same was the position on the last two dates.

[3] Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab, puts in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State on an advance copy of petition having been sent to him, and submits that the petitioners are accused of stealing copper wires from the transformers installed in the fields during night time and are members of a gang, which is involved in such like activities. There are many such cases registered against the petitioners, details of which have been recorded by the learned Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib, in its order dated 24.05.2023, vide which their application for grant of anticipatory bail had been dismissed.

[4] In view of the above, it appears that the petitioners are not serious in pursuing the present petition.

[5] Dismissed for want of prosecution.
