This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 7.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is an old lady of 70 years whose son and husband had already died and she is now living with her daughter-in-law. Petitioner has one unmarried daughter namely Savita Devi (respondent No. 6 herein) who is living separately from petitioner with respondent No. 7, without any wedlock. Petitioner and respondent No. 6 are not having good relations and they are not on talking terms since very long. Civil litigation is also running between them and respondent No. 6 wants to grab the house of the petitioner and is harassing and threatening the petitioner to implicate her in some false case and to eliminate her. It has been submitted that representation dated 18.4.2023 (Annexure P-2) was also given to the SSP, Fazilka, but no action has been taken to decide the same.

Without commenting on the merits of case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3-SSP, Fazilka to decide the

representation of the petitioner dated 18.4.2023 (Annexure P-2), preferably within a period of one month, and take necessary action, if any required, as per law.

Disposed of.
