ALOK JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed *inter alia* praying for protection of the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondent.

2. After arguing vehemently on the merits of the case, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to avail remedy under Section 156 Cr.P.C.

3. Learned State counsel assisted by counsel for respondent No.6 have no objection, however, submits that the liberty should not be construed as any direction by this Court.

4. According the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the counsel for the petitioners to avail remedy under Section 156 Cr.P.C., wherein he should demonstrate with cogent evidence as to why any investigation is required in the said complaint.

5. It is made clear that filing or pendency of this petition or any order/direction passed in this petition shall not be an alibi or defence to the petitioners, in case, they are found involved in any illegal activity and /or in violation of any qua which the respondent-Authorities shall take appropriate action, in accordance with law.
