1. The learned counsel appearing for respondent No. 3 submits that he has instructions to state that the Authority who adjourned sine die thus through an order Annexure P-7, hence the proceedings drawn against the petitioner herein, through invocation of Sections 4, 5, 7 of the Public Premises Act, be permitted to re-open the same, and, also further submits, that after issuance of notices to the litigants concerned, the Authority seized with case No. 7/SDO, shall fix therein a date for the appearance before him of the litigants concerned.

2. In view of the above, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that thus he has instructions to withdraw the instant writ petition.

3. Prayer accepted. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of, as withdrawn, but with liberty to the petitioner to raise all his permissible pleas before the Collector concerned.

4. The Authority concerned, after hearing all affected persons concerned, shall positively draw a reasoned decision upon the above lis but within six months from today.
