The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ directing the respondents to issue the fresh passport to the petitioner and also condone the ban on issuance of the fresh passport to the petitioner for remaining six months as out of five years ban imposed by the RPO, Chandigarh nearly four and half years have already lapsed.
