The petitioner has filed the petition for quashing of the order dated 10.03.2023 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Chandigarh, in case FIR No.225 dated 28.07.2015, registered under Sections 406, 407, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Industrial Area, District Chandigarh.

Vide order dated 22.06.2023 passed by a Coordinate Bench, the petitioner was directed to surrender before the learned trial Court with a direction to the learned trial Court to enlarge the petitioner on bail on his appearance, on furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the satisfaction of the Court. As per the zimni order dated 25.07.2023 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Chandigarh, the petitioner has surrendered before the Court and now he is on bail.

Since pursuant to the order dated 22.06.2023, the petitioner has surrendered before the Court and at present he is on bail, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 22.06.2023 granting *interim* bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
