The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing Anisha (Detenue) wife of the petitioner from the illegal custody of the private respondents as well as their companions.

Vide order dated 20.06.2023, notice of motion was issued.

Mr. Anil Kumar Lamdharia, APP, UT has put in appearance on behalf of the official respondents and on instructions from SI Mohan Kashyap submits that the statement of the detenue Nisha (wife of the petitioner) has been recorded on 28.06.2023 itself, wherein she has denied all the allegations as alleged in the petition and has stated that she has gone back to respondents No. 4 to 8 who are stated to be her family members, by her own sweet will.

Keeping in view the statement made by the learned State

counsel, nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present petition.

At this stage, Mr. Maninder Arora, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No. 5 to 8 by filing his Vakalatnama and has endorsed the statement made by learned State counsel and also submitted that some documents of the detainee Nisha, wife of the petitioner are lying with the petitioner.

Faced with this, the petitioner, who is present in the Court, has handed over the Voter ID and Aadhar Card (in original) to learned counsel for respondent Nos. 5 to 8 in the Court itself. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes that the remaining documents shall be handed over to the Investigating Officer within a period of one week.

Disposed of accordingly.
