By way of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.236 dated 08.08.2018 registered under Sections 302/307/333/353/186/34/120-B IPC and Sections 25 and 29(A) of Arms Act and Section 3(2)(V) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 at Police Station Arya Nagar, Rohtak.

Custody certificate has been placed on record.

It is informed by learned State Counsel that out of 44 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 27 have already been examined whereas 07 witnesses have been given up and thus only 10 witnesses are left to be examined.

This Court vide order dated 01.12.2022, has already given directions to the trial Court for recording the prosecution evidence by taking necessary steps for the purpose of securing the presence of remaining PWs.

Having regard to the fact that this is a case of double murder

and is in the nature of an honour killing, this Court is not inclined to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
