In the present case, the suit filed by the respondent-plaintiff was dismissed by the trial court, wherein, he had challenged the order of punishment dated 13.12.2004 of dismissal from service. The lower appellate court thereafter upheld the order of dismissal but only gave liberty to the respondent-plaintiff to raise his claim before appellants-defendants for amendment of the punishment keeping in view Rule 16.2 of Punjab Police Rules.

Learned counsel for the appellants-defendants submits that as the punishment of dismissal has been kept intact even by the lower appellate court, which order has not been challenged by the respondent-plaintiff, appropriate order keeping in view the direction given by the lower appellate court will be passed by the concerned authorities within a period of two

months from the date of receipt of copy of this order and the present appeal be disposed off having not been pressed any further.
