Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the prayer of the petitioners in the present petitions is for regularization of their services w.e.f. 07.03.1996/18.03.1996 on the ground that the employees junior to them have been regularized from the said date.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that nothing has been mentioned in the petitions as to whether the petitioners fulfill all the requirements/conditions as per the policies dated 07.03.1996/18.03.1996 copies of which have been appended with the present petitions as Annexures P/1 and P/2.

Learned counsel for the petitioners objects to the said averments of the learned counsel for the respondents and submits that the petitioners fulfill all the requirements/conditions of the policies in question hence, the petitioners are entitled for consideration of their claim for regularization of their services under the policies Annexure P/1 and P/2.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the petitioners file any representation with the respondents giving details as to how the petitioners are eligible for regularization of their services under the policies Annexure P/1 and P/2, the same will be considered and an

appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of any such representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that an appropriate representation/claim will be filed with the respondents giving details of each petitioner qua the number of days for which he/she has worked in each year to show that their claim for regularization of their services is covered under the policies Annexures P/1 and P/2 and the respondents be directed to pass an appropriate order, hence, the present petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.

Civil miscellaneous application pending, if any, stands disposed of.
