1. The petitioner is undergoing life sentence on account of his conviction under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860. He was granted parole with effect from 07.04.2023 to 03.06.2023. Thereafter, he came to the High Court with an application for the extension of the period of parole on the ground that he has to undergo surgery for 'Hernia' and removal of 'Gall Bladder stone'. Accordingly, he was granted extension upto 03.07.2023. Now a fresh petition has been filed stating that the surgery for removal of gall bladder is still to be performed. On this ground the extension has been sought.

2. This court has heard the learned counsel representing the petitioner.

3. As per the rules, the petitioner has already enjoyed the period of parole. Thereafter, the Court in exercise of its power has extended the period by 30 days.

4. In these circumstances, this court does not find it appropriate to grant any further extension. Once the petitioner surrenders, the Jail Superintendent is directed to take steps for medical intervention, if found necessary.
5. Disposed of accordingly.
6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
