1. The petitioner has preferred this writ petition for directing the respondents to treat the petitioner as regularly appointed employee from the date the petitioner's services have been taken over after the college was taken over by the University.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention to Annexure P/1 to point out that as on 01.01.2005, the petitioner was informed that his services had been regularized as he was working since December, 1996, on the post of Ground Man-cum-Mali in the college. However, the University on taking over the college on 07.04.2005, treated the petitioner on fixed salary. Thereafter, the petitioner submitted representation to the authorities to place him in the regular pay scale but was not granted the same.

3. The case of the petitioner is similar to the case of Gurmeet Singh, decided by this Court of even date in CWP-2517-2013.

4. In view thereof, the writ petition is allowed with directions to the respondents-University to treat the petitioner as regularly appointed

Chowkidar/Mali/Ground Man and pay him regular pay scale and make his pay fixation from time to time accordingly. Arrears shall be calculated and released to him within a period of three months henceforth.

5. All pending misc. application(s) also stand disposed of.
