The instant Revision Petition has been preferred by the petitioner under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 18.05.2022 passed by the court of learned Additional District Judge, Charkhi Dadri in Civil Misc. Appeal No.4 of 2020 instituted by the contesting respondent/defendant no.12, vide which the Appellate Court has passed *status quo* order against the order dated 19.02.2020 passed by the court of learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Charkhi Dadri.

Pursuant to the notice of motion issued on 29.07.2022, Mr. Sumit Sangwan, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent no.1, who is the only contesting respondent, and filed Power of Attorney, which is taken on record, and he has produced a copy of the order dated 30.11.2022 passed by the court of learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Charkhi Dadri, whereby the Civil Suit No.468 of 2019 titled as '*Sombir versus Suresh and others*' has been dismissed for want of prosecution as well as non-compliance of directions issued by the trial court for effecting publication through the newspaper and he submits that since the original suit itself has been disposed of, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous. Copy of said order is taken on record.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the instant petition, in case the aforesaid civil suit is restored by the trial Court.
