1. The petitioners are seeking to quash the FIR No.0133 dated 08.12.2017 under Sections 313/323/34/498-A/506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, and later on challan has been presented under Section 323/406/506 and 498-A IPC, registered at Women Police Station Jind, District Jind and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise.

2. As per the report received from the learned trial Court, the case was disposed of on 13.02.2023 and the accused were acquitted.

3. Status report by way of affidavit of Ravi Khundia, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jind on behalf of respondent No.1 has been placed on record.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Geeta, submits that during the course of investigation, the other accused were found to be innocent and the challan was presented only against petitioner No.1, who has been acquitted by the learned trial Court in terms of the judgment dated 13.02.2023. Copy of the judgment has also been annexed with the status report. He further submits that as petitioner No.1, the sole accused, has been

acquitted by the learned trial Court, the present petition has become infructuous.

5. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
