1. The petitioners are seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.202 dated 11.09.2022 under Sections 324, 323, 341, 34 IPC and Sections 325, 326 IPC added later on Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur (Annexure P-1).
2. On the last date of hearing/on 20.07.2023 while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioners and asked them to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel contends that petitioner No. 1 has been attributed injuries on the forehead, leg and right elbow of the injured complainant none of which were grievous in nature. Petitioner No. 2 too has been attributed simple injuries with a *danda* on the person of the complainant. He submits that the petitioners are ready to join investigation and cooperate with the investigating agency.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of order dated 20.07.2023, the petitioners have joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.
4. Learned State counsel does not dispute the factum of the petitioners having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, further submits that the petitioners are not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.
5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 20.07.2023, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
