DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondents No. 4 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner and respondent No.4 are wife and husband and the petitioner is living separately from respondent No.4 as he used to give beatings to the petitioner. It is further contended that on 21.06.2023 the petitioner went to market at City Batala, District Gurdaspur and on that day respondent No.4 and one unknown person met the petitioner and gave beatings to the petitioner. Thereafter, the petitioner raised hue and cry and the people gathered had rescued the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that representation (Annexure P-1) in this regard has already been submitted by the petitioner before respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala District Gurdaspur, which has not been taken into consideration so far and he would be satisfied if the said representation is

decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of Motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Hakam Singh, AAG Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and has no objection if the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is accepted.

In view of the above and with the consent of both the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala District Gurdaspur to look into the grievances of the petitioner as set out in the representation (Annexure P-1) and dispose it of within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Present petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
