AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. The present petition has been filed for quashing of the order dated 24th August, 2016 declaring petitioner proclaimed offender in FIR No. 25, dated 9th February, 2013, under Sections 323, 427 and 506 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Sector 3, Chandigarh.

2. On 29th July, 2022, notice of motion was issued by this Court considering that petitioner was ready to surrender and deposit cost of ₹90,000/- with the Legal Service Authority, U.T., Chandigarh. It was directed that on surrender petitioner be released on interim bail subject to furnishing of bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Magistrate. The needful was to be done within three weeks.

3. In order dated 30th August, 2022, this Court noted that ₹90,000/- was deposited with Legal Service Authority, U.T., Chandigarh but the petitioner could not surrender due to medical reasons. The time to surrender was extended upto 15th September, 2022.

4. Learned counsel for U.T., Chandigarh submits that petitioner had surrendered before the trial Court and released on interim bail.

5. In view of the above, no further directions are called for, the petition is disposed of.

6. Needless to say that court concerned would be at liberty to impose such conditions as deemed necessary for ensuring the presence of the petitioner.

7. Since the main case has been disposed of, pending application if any is rendered infructuous.
