HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.155 dated 05.07.2022, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Buria, District Yamuna Nagar.

2 As per the allegations levelled in the FIR, petitioner while taking loan from some financial institution, showed the complainant as guarantor by forging her signatures.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the loan liability now stands discharged with the deposit of due amount with the financial institution i.e. HDFC Bank Ltd., Bhagwanpur Branch, District Yamuna Nagar. He further submits that the misunderstanding with the complainant also stand resolved now.

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from

ASI Nirmal Chand, submits that the petitioner has failed to cooperate with the investigating agency.

5. Ms. Jasleen Kaur, Advocate representing the complainant submits that the misunderstanding and the confusion between the petitioner and the complainant stands resolved with the intervention of respectables and the complainant is left with no grievance.

6. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the paper book, I find that no recovery proceedings are pending against the petitioner at the instance of financial institution, thereby, drawing inference that all the liability has been discharged at his instance. More than that, the complainant has also resolved her dispute with the petitioner and as such, in these facts and circumstances, the petition is allowed and order dated 14.03.2023 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute.
