(1) Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that through the present petition the relief which the petitioners were seeking was for investigation into the complaints made by the petitioners with regard to illegal appointments to the department of Railways, Government of India which, at the time of filing of the present petition, was being brushed under the carpet by the State.

(2) At the outset, learned State counsel submits that the present petition has been filed under a misconception that the State was brushing the petitioners' complaint under the carpet as a formal FIR has been registered by the State which is being investigated fairly.

(3) In the light of the above stand taken by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition.
