1. Despite the co-respondents No.2 and 3 being served through substituted mode of service, yet they are neither present in person, nor they any validly engaged counsel. Therefore, the co-respondents No.2 and 3 are ordered to be proceeded against ex parte.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present writ petition.
3. Leave granted.
4. Consequently, the extant writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, liberty is reserved to the petitioner to access the jurisdictionally competent civil court concerned, for claiming therebefore, a path or a rasta, thus on the premise of easement of necessity or prescription.
