Prayer in the present writ petition is for taking appropriate action against respondents No.7 and 8 alleging that they are trying to take possession of the vehicle of the petitioner bearing registration No.PB-04-V-6576, forcibly and with the help of recovery agents.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.7 and 8 has placed on record a consent letter dated 23.08.2022 executed between the petitioner and the Insurance Company whereby the claim has been mutually settled and the petitioner has undertaken not to raise any issue or litigation on this score.

In view of the same, present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to seek revival in case the above said consent letter is found to be incorrect.
