This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to provide amenities namely drains, roads, sewerage, street lights etc.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has submitted that necessary facilities have already been provided and thus, the present Civil Writ Petition has been rendered infructuous.

Today, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner in order to rebut the abovesaid aspect. Even on 27.09.2022 also, no one had appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present case or to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives to the petitioner.
