The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents authority to prepare the merit list for the post of Clerk afresh as per criteria laid down in the Advertisement dated 21.05.2021 (Annexure P-1), where the petitioner has secured 63.5 marks, but was allocated only 59.091 marks without following any criteria.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim of the petitioner has been considered, he has since been appointed and the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner admits that the claim of the petitioner is satisfied and the present petition has thus rendered infructuous.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
