1. The petitioner's appeal is pending before the Commissioner for (Panchayat Land) S.A.S. Nagar and Rupnagar, for 11.07.2023. By a totally non-speaking order, the status quo order previously passed has been vacated vide order dated 13.06.2023. From the reading of the order, the reasons for vacating the interim order earlier passed are not discernible.

2. Since, the appeal is listed for 11.07.2023 before the Commissioner for (Panchayat Land) S.A.S. Nagar and Rupnagar and the learned counsel representing the petitioner undertakes to finally address the arguments in the pending appeal on 11.07.2023, hence, it is considered appropriate to dispose of the writ petition by directing the parties to maintain status quo till the decision of the appeal. The Commissioner is requested to make sincere endeavours for the final decision of the appeal in the month of July, 2023.

3. Since, this order has been passed without hearing the Gram Panchayat or the State, hence, they shall have the liberty to file their

objections, if any.

4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
