By way of present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 30.06.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined in the investigation, hence, prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order 30.06.2023.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Irshad Ali, P.S. Sector-17, HUDA, Jagadhari, District Yamuna Nagar, intimates that

the petitioner had joined in the investigation in the case and is no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor he is required for further investigation.

4. Keeping in view the respective submissions made by learned State counsel and considering the fact that the petitioner had already joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation nor he is required for any custodial interrogation, interim bail granted vide order dated 30.06.2023 is hereby confirmed in the present FIR No.177, dated 15.06.2023 under 323, 452, 506 and 34 of IPC and Section 326 of IPC added later on (Annexure P-1), subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, that the petitioner will come and join the investigation as and when so required; will not tamper with the evidence and will not leave the country without prior permission and will appear in Court on each and every date of hearing.

5. The petition stands allowed.
