This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondents No. 4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to file fresh representation as the representation dated 21.06.2023 (Annexure P-5) has already been submitted before respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala and Station House Officer, Dana Mandi, Patiala, which has not been taken into consideration.

Notice of Motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Jashandeep Singh, AAG Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

After going through the contents of the representation, the representation seems to be vague, wherein no specific detail has been mentioned.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners will file a detailed representation before respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala and he be directed to look into the grievances of the petitioners.

Prayer is allowed and petitioners are directed to file a detailed representation before respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala as the life and liberty of the petitioners is at stake.

On their doing so, respondents No.2 is directed to look into the grievances of the petitioners and to deal with the representation in accordance with law.
