AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

As agreed, (statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded) a sum of Rs.6,20,000/- (Rupees Six Lakhs Twenty Thousand only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim.

Learned counsel for the appellants states that out of the amount i.e. Rs.6,20,000/-, Rs.1,00,000/- be paid to appellant No.5-Leela Devi and the remaining amount of Rs.5,20,000/- be disbursed in the name of appellant No.1-Bimla Devi. It is further undertaken that in case in future any claim is raised by any other appellant(s), the appellants No.1 & 5 shall indemnify the said claimant (s).

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit two cheques, one for Rs.5,20,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Twenty Thousand only) favouring appellant No. 1-Bimla Devi wd/o Brij Pal, other for Rs.1,00,000/-(Rupees One Lakh Only) favouring appellant No.5-Leela Devi w/o Faquir Chand with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 09.11.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall

counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
