This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to hold a regular inquiry into the allegations made against respondent No.4 as well as for directing respondent No.4 to permit the petitioner to complete the work about construction of passage, situated in village Kaler Khurd, Block Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur.

Today, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner inspite of the fact that on 16.03.2023, it had been specifically ordered that the case would be taken up at 3.00 PM.

None had appeared on behalf of the petitioner on 07.01.2019, 04.04.2019, 10.05.2022 and 16.01.2023.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
