1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as the
department has already promoted certain persons to the post of
Accountant and few posts are still lying vacant and the said vacant posts
are also to be filled up by the department for the smooth working, hence,

the only grievance, which survives, of the petitioners is that at the moment as the posts are lying vacant and they are eligible for the said posts, their claim be for promotion to the post of Accountant/Assistant be considered.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners intend to make a representation claiming the said benefit from the respondents and the respondents be directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner so that petitioners do not suffer any prejudice.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, any post is lying vacant and the department is of the view that the same are to be filled up for the smooth functioning of the department, the same will be filled up in accordance with law by considering the claim of all eligibles including the petitioners, if found eligible to be considered keeping in view their qualification and seniority and any representation made by the petitioners claiming the said promotion will be decided by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the above statement of learned State counsel, the present petition

may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, at this stage.
