1. The petitioners in both the above detailed cases are seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.52 dated 10.06.2023 for the offences under Sections 306, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Bareta, District Mansa.

2. On 03.07.2023, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioners and asked them to join

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investigation:-

“Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners, inter alia, submit that totally false and frivolous allegations have been levelled against them of having abetted the suicide of the deceased (husband of the complainant) by taunting him time and again qua his wife’s i.e. complainant’s alleged illicit relations with one Jagtar Singh.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of order dated 03.07.2023, the petitioners have joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Kuldeep Singh, submits that the investigating agency had not found any substance in the allegations levelled and a cancellation report is likely to be filed in the very near future by the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioners are not required for further investigation much less for their custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petitions are allowed and interim order dated 03.07.2023, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
