This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the result of the petitioner (Annexure P-7) uploaded on the web site of respondent No.2 on 15.07.2022, whereby he has been declared failed in Document Verification of Stage-II of selection procedure, on the ground that petitioner had annexed all the documents with the application leaving no discrepancy.

On 28.07.2022, the following order was passed by this Court:

"It is submitted by the counsel for the petitioner that the unfortunate discrepancy in the date of 10th class certificate has happened only because the petitioner had uploaded the copy of duplicate certificate of 10th class which was issued on 25.09.2018, whereas, actually the petitioner had passed the 10th class exam in March, 2016 only. Therefore, in effect, information furnished by the petitioner is perfectly correct and justified.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Arvind Seth, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and seeks time to file written statement.

Adjourned to 27.01.2023.

In the meantime, the petitioner shall be permitted to participate in the process of selection and be considered for selection and appointment, as per his merit, subject to the decision of the present petition.

Let respondent No.2 be served in ordinary course for the date fixed.

A copy of this order be given to learned counsel for the parties under the signature of Bench Secretary of this Court”

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner states that after completion of the process of selection, the petitioner stands inducted as a Navik (General Duty) and in this regard, he refers to the stand of the respondents in the written statement, which reads as under:

“That the candidate is in the merit and an E-admit card for Stage-III has been issued to the candidate and directed to report at INS Chilka on 01 Aug 22 for further participate in the recruitment process at Stage III and induction will be subject to medical clearance. The candidate has reported at INS (Indian Navel Ship) Chilka on 01.08.2022. It is further submitted that as per the interim report submitted by Indian Navel Ship, Chilka, petitioner has been inducted for training.”

Mr. Seth, learned counsel for respondent No.1 states that the grievance raised by the petitioner stands redressed.

Mr. Rajesh Hooda, learned counsel for the petitioner also states that indeed nothing survives for adjudication in this petition.

Disposed off as infructuous.
