Prayer in this petition is made for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.24, dated 01.04.2019, registered at Police Station Kulgari, District Ferozepur, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 336, 506, 427, 148, 149 of IPC, besides Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

It is is stated by learned State counsel that petitioner has been found innocent during investigation. However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after declaring the petitioner as innocent, he has been summoned by the Court under Section 193 Cr.P.C. At the same time, it is pointed out that matter has since been compromised. The quashing petition has already been filed and parties have been directed to appear before the Trial Court for recording their statement with regard to the compromise, the copy of that order is Annexure P-6.

In view of the above, the inteirm order dated 29.07.2022, whereby the petitioner was granted interim bail, is hereby made abslolute.
