AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. The lawyers are abstaining from work.
2. This petition is filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 47, dated 13th March, 2023, under Sections 21, 21(b), 29 and 27(a) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'the NDPS Act'), registered at Police Station Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur.
3. As per the case set up, on 13th March, 2023, police party apprehended Lucky-petitioner and seven grams of *Heroin* alongwith Rs.4500/- alleged drug money were recovered from him.
4. Petitioner is in custody since 13th March, 2023, recovery from the petitioner is of non-commercial quantity and marginally above small quantity.
5. Considering the facts and circumstance in totality and that conclusion of trial is likely to take time, no useful purpose would be served by depriving the petitioner from personal liberty, the petitioner is granted

bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

- 6. The petition is allowed.
- 7. It is clarified that observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
- 8. In case there is a factual error or substantial ground for opposing the prayer, the State shall be at liberty for recalling of the order.
