Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.251 dated 11.7.2022 registered under Sections 147, 149, 323, 506 IPC at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.

As per allegations recorded in the FIR, the petitioner along with other co-accused caused injuries to complainant-Ranbir, Rajesh and Kalu with different weapons.

On 29.7.2022, this Court passed detailed order while granting interim bail to the petitioner with direction to join the investigation.

Counsel for the petitioner apprised the Court that only simple injuries are attributed to the petitioner and in compliance of the earlier order, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police.

State counsel on instructions from SI Dilbagh Singh submits that indeed, the petitioner who caused simple injuries has joined the

investigation with the police and recovery of weapon used by the petitioner

in the commission of crime is also effected along with one motorcycle and now the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 29.7.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
