The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.32 dated 31.01.2023 under Sections 15 & 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Section 29 of NDPS Act added later on) registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur. This is second petition filed by the petitioner.

The previous petition, wherein similar relief had been sought, was dismissed as withdrawn on a prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, since this Court did not find any merit in his submissions.

On a pointed query put to the learned counsel as to whether there had been any material change in circumstances which would

warrant entertaining the instant petition, he fairly concedes that there has been no material change in the circumstances.

In these circumstances, this Court is not inclined to entertain the instant petition.

Dismissed.
