Seeking issuance of directions to register the FIR against respondents No.6 & 7 in complaint made by the petitioners, the petitioners have come up before this Court.

2. Counsel for the petitioners submits that the FIR has been registered rendering the present petition infructuous.

3. Given above, the present petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous. It is well settled that in case, any person has any grievance, they are supposed to file complaint under Section 154 CrPC and in case, cognizable offence is made out, it is for the concerned police Station to register the complaint. Apart from that, the petitioners have an alternative remedy to file a complaint under Section 156 CrPC and also to file a private complaint under Section 190 CrPC. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
