Today, at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to raise all the pleas, as have been raised herein, before the trial Court at appropriate stage including his plea to the effect that the complainant had as a matter of fact been making payments towards installments for about 4 years, but later turned around as he was not getting returns on the said investment and also a submission to the effect that no preliminary enquiry was conducted before lodging of FIR.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

Needless to mention, the trial Court shall pass a speaking order discussing all the contentions as may be raised before it.
