Through this writ petition filed under Article 226 Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks indulgence of this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to the official respondents to release the EPF contribution along with interest from the date of accrual till its payment.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel is unable to point out any *prima facie* material to show that indeed his services with Punjab Municipal Infrastructure Development Company, Chandigarh were deriving the benefit of Employees Provident Fund and the communication appended with the writ petition relates to the request made by the petitioner for correction regarding the provident fund account details including father's name.

When confronted with the maintainability of the writ petition based upon disputed facts, learned counsel does not press this petition in order to avail the alternative remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
