The present petition had been filed raising a challenge to the letter/orders date 05.03.2015 (Annexure P-9) and the order dated 18.03.2015 (Annexure P-7) whereby the pension received by the petitioner being freedom fighter had been stopped.

It had transpired during the pendency of the proceedings that Shanti Devi had since then passed away.

Counsel for the petitioner had prayed time to seek instructions from the dependents and to determine as to whether they would be entitled to the pension as per the applicable policy or not. The

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matter has thereafter been adjourned on successive occasions to enable the counsel for the petitioner to seek instructions.

On resumed hearing Mr. Nakul Sharma, Advocate has apprised that the client has no more in contact with him and he is not in receipt of any updated instructions.

Dismissed for want of prosecution.

Liberty is, however, granted to seek revival of the present petition as and when such cause of action accrues.
