After arguing at some length, the learned counsel representing the parties have arrived at a consensus. They jointly pray that the writ petition be disposed of, while granting opportunity to the petitioner, to make a representation, in order to explain his position, while directing the competent authority-Civil Surgeon, Patiala, to pass a fresh order, after considering all aspects of the matter.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, Civil Surgeon, Patiala is directed to pass a fresh order, within a period of 15 days, from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Till a fresh order is passed by the Civil Surgeon, Patiala, interim order dated 03.04.2017 shall continue to operate.
