This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the order dated 25.05.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent no.4 and order dated 27.06.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent no.6 vide which an enquiry into the works done by the petitioner during her tenure have been initiated.

Learned State counsel has submitted that only a notice dated 25.05.2022, asking for the record, has been issued against the petitioner, against which the present writ petition has been filed and even proceedings under Section 216(4) of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994, have not been initiated till date and thus, the present writ petition is premature. It is submitted that in case, any action is to be taken against the petitioner, then the same would be done in accordance with law to which the petitioner would have a right to file reply.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the above, seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take up all the points raised in the present petition in case any proceeding is initiated against the present petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
