VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.1 to consider, enquire and decide the complaint dated 16.06.2023 (Annexure P-15) on the “arbitrary drawls” being made on the orders of respondent No.4.

2. Learned State Counsel, on the basis of written instructions dated 09.10.2023 received from the office of Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Home Department, has submitted that respondent No.1 would consider and decide the complaint within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the said

complaint has been pending since 16.06.2023 and the period of three months is rather long for a decision on the same and prays that the same be reduced.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider the complaint dated 16.06.2023 (Annexure P-15) within a period of 10 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.

5. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and respondent No.1 would consider and decide the same independently, in accordance with law.

6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
