JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

On 28.08.2023, the following order was passed:-

“The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the order dated 02.06.2023 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Judge, Special Court, Ferozepur vide which the bail order of the petitioner had been cancelled and his bail/surety bonds had been forfeited to the State and non-bailable warrants had been issued for 08.09.2023 in case FIR No.80 dated 25.07.2019 under Sections 21/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Kulgarhi, District Ferozepur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was unable to appear on the date fixed i.e. 02.06.2023 before the Trial Court under the impression that the next date of hearing was 02.07.2023 and not 02.06.2023 because of which the impugned order came to be passed. He states that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

Notice of motion for 20.09.2023.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one

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week from today and subject to a deposit of Rs25,000/- as costs with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association, Chandigarh Lawyers Family Welfare Fund, Account No.41564846387, SBI High Court Branch, IFSC:-SBIN0050306, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The learned counsel for the petitioner shall produce the receipt regarding deposit of Rs.25,000/- with the aforesaid Association as well as a copy of the order granting interim bail to the petitioner on the next date of hearing.”

In furtherance to the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered on 01.09.2023 and has since been released on interim bail. The copy of the said order is marked as ‘X’.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

It is expected that the petitioner shall not absent himself from Trial without sufficient cause.
