Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.18 dated 29.1.2022 registered under Sections 61 of Excise Act at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar Rural.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of previous order of interim bail, the petitioner has joined the investigation and even recoveries are also effected.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Balkar Singh apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and recoveries stand effected in the present case and the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 1.8.2022

is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under
Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
