ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN J. (Oral)

The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 07.03.2012 passed in CWP No.4380 of 2012, vide which the parties were directed to maintain status quo till the next date of hearing.

As per the reply filed by the Naib Tehsildar-cum-Assistance Collector IInd Grade, Hansi, it is stated that the petitioner, on an earlier occasion, has filed COCP No.1311 of 2022 and has also filed objections on 16.06.2022 before the District Revenue Officer. Thereafter, when after conducting the demarcation, the objections were dismissed on 25.07.2022, the petitioner withdrew his earlier COCP on 25.07.2022. It is also submitted that the order dated 25.07.2022 is challenged before the Appellate Authority, which is still pending.

Similar stand is taken by the respondent No.3 and additionally, it is stated that in order to avoid any untoward incident,

preventive action under Sections 107/151 Cr.P.C., is taken against the petitioner and respondent No.1 vide DDR No.20 dated 21.06.2022.

In the reply filed by respondent No.1, it is submitted that after 30.03.2012, the status quo order was never extended and therefore, there is no violation of the order on behalf of the respondents as the matter is still sub judice before the Court.

Accordingly, in view of the specific stand taken by the petitioner, this petition is dismissed.
